



## Child Care Checklist

### Important Reminders for Parents

- All items must be **clearly labeled** with your child's name.
- Supplies should be **replenished as needed**.
- For safety reasons, please do not send toys from home unless approved.

### Infant Checklist

#### Daily Care Items

- Diapers (disposable or cloth, labeled)
- Wipes (labeled)
- Diaper rash cream or ointment (if needed, with written permission)
- At least **2–3 complete changes of clothes** (labeled)

#### Feeding Items

- Bottles (labeled with child's name)
- Formula or breast milk (clearly labeled with name and date)
- Baby food, if applicable
- Bibs

### **Comfort & Sleep Items**

- Pacifier (if used, labeled)
- Small comfort item (blanket or soft toy, if permitted)

### **Health & Safety Items**

- Sunscreen (if applicable, with written permission)
- Any required medications (with completed authorization forms)

### **Seasonal Items**

- Weather-appropriate outerwear (jacket, hat, etc.)

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## **Toddler Checklist**

### **Daily Care Items**

- Diapers or pull-ups (labeled)
- Wipes (labeled)
- Diaper rash cream or ointment (if needed, with written permission)
- At least **2 complete changes of clothes** (labeled)

### **Feeding Items**

- Sippy cup or spill-proof cup (labeled)
- Toddler meals or snacks, if applicable

### **Nap & Comfort Items**

- Small blanket or nap mat (if required by program)
- Comfort item for nap time (if used)

### **Health & Safety Items**

- Sunscreen (if applicable, with written permission)
- Any required medications (with completed authorization forms)

### **Personal & Seasonal Items**

- Sneakers or closed-toe shoes
- Weather-appropriate clothing (jacket, hat, gloves, or sun hat)
